

LAPTOP HOME USE PROCEDURES

Responsibility

- In order to sign out a computer to take home, parent(s)/guardian(s) and students must attend a Family Orientation meeting scheduled by the school.
- It is the responsibility of the student and parent/guardian to know the guidelines attached to this document. Guidelines are reviewed when students receive the laptop and when parent(s)/guardian(s) attend the mandatory orientation session.
- The iBook issued to each student is an educational tool and should only be used in that capacity.
- Parent(s)/guardian(s) will have their child's login password in order to supervise student's usage at home.
- Replacement costs and/or the repair for damages that are not covered by the warrantee and that occur to the iBook and its carrying case while it is signed out are the sole responsibility of the undersigned parent(s)/guardian(s).
- If the iBook is stolen while signed out to a student, it should be reported to the local police authorities and appropriate school immediately.
- Laptops taken out of state are not covered by Apple for any kind of loss or damage.
- Failure to comply with the school's policy for iBook sign-out may result in your sign-out privileges being revoked.
